

# Free Design

## Green Man paper pattern pieces



Cut out the paper templates below to make the Green Man embroidery in felt (see the video on my YouTube channel, Sarah Homfray Embroidery!). Place them on your felt, draw around them and cut out the felt. Use the 'Prick and pounce' method to transfer the face design onto your felt, or the 'Trace and tack' method, or cut out the eyes and use them as pattern pieces. The mouth can be put on later; the lines are guides to where the leaves go but you can place them in position and decide where you like them before you stitch them down.

### Pattern pieces

This is the small design I worked in the video. See the next page for a large version!

#### Felt colours:

Colour 1 - Brown

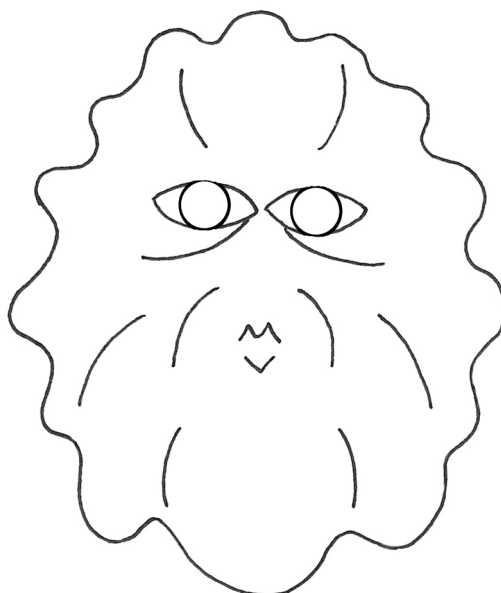
Colour 2 – Dark green

Colour 3 – Light green



#### Nose felt pattern

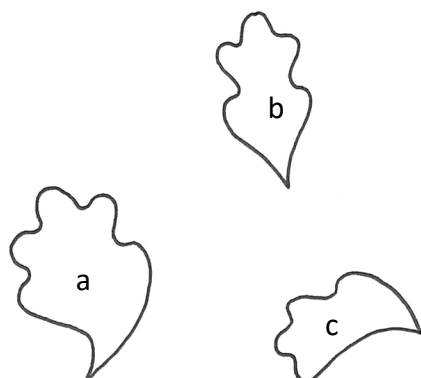
Cut one in colour 3 - light green



Base felt layer for under the leaves.

Cut one in colour 1 - brown

Transfer the eye details onto your felt



Leaves pattern pieces (turn over to get left and right facing leaves). Once cut place on colour design over page to organise them.

Leaf a –

- Cut 1 x left facing in dark green
- Cut 1 x right facing in dark green
- Cut 3 x left facing in light green
- Cut 3 x right facing in light green

Leaf b – Cut 4 in brown

- Cut 4 in dark green

Leaf c – Cut 2 left facing in dark green

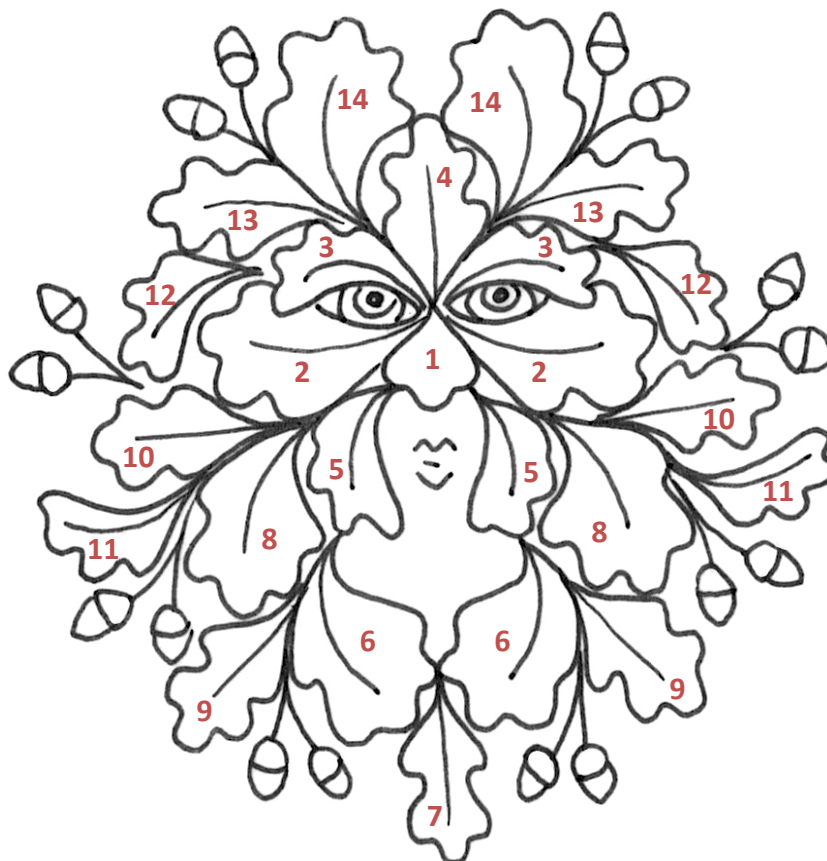
- Cut 2 right facing in dark green
- Cut 2 left facing in light green
- Cut 2 right facing in light green
